



## Tchuma Tchato Project 2007

The “Tchuma Tchato” project had its starting point in Lake Cahora Bassa, Mozambique. At the time of the big floods which caused devastation to a good part of the Mozambican people in the beginning of the year 2000, we were very much involved with disaster relief together with other churches and organisations, in a coalition that was formed for that purpose. It was called Missions Relief Coalition (MRC). Resulting from the contacts that were made, and through a prominent Christian business man from Nelspruit, the Lord led us to visit the villages of Daque e Magoé, on the south shore of Lake Cahora Bassa. Since then we have returned 3 more times, bringing the Word of God, training, fellowship, comfort and humanitarian supplies. We have come to love the people from this remote part of Mozambique who from their want are still able to muster up physical hospitality. – Meanwhile we have ministered to the Mozambican people in other parts and other ways, always with them in our heart, mind and prayers. We believe it’s the Lord’s time for another visit, to consolidate the connection. So, Lord willing during the course of this year, we will be preparing a trip to Cahora Bassa in the beginning of 2007!



Since the first outreach trip, it has been a priority to include young people, so when we no longer are able to accomplish such task, they in turn will have the vision and Christ’s loving constraint to carry on. – On previous trips we have been the most 9 people in 3 vehicles and a bush trailer. This time we will have 10 people in the core team. Then we will consider anyone else, as long as they will provide their own means of transportation, the necessary funds for the trip expenses and the organisational fee. – Following are the “Expedition General Guidelines,” the “Budget and Logistics,” “Itinerary” and contact numbers to acquire other pertinent information, for those who will be interested in participating, either by integrating and/or sponsoring the expedition.



## EXPEDITION GENERAL GUIDELINES

This trip is organised and promoted by “Aurora Missionary Action – AMA” Association, linked to the Christian Movement “The Family International.” We therefore urge all those who want to be part of it to brush up their Christian values and the certainty of eternal Salvation by grace! (Ephesians 2:8,9) – Furthermore those who will integrate the expedition will comply with the following requirements: 1. Present a letter of reference from a member of the Association. 2. Make proof of physical health and that there are no ailments who will cause risk to the person’s well being or that of others. 3. Make proof of the means of transportation and necessary funds for the expedition, as laid out in the budget. 4. Valid passport for at least 1 year. 5. Sign the disclaimer which will free the expedition core team from any responsibility concerning the person and the person’s belongings during the duration of the expedition (at own discretion, those who will may acquire personal insurance). 6. Pay the organisational fee (300 Euros = 2.400 Rand). 7. Commit to strive for a spirit of joy and camaraderie.



## EXPEDITION BUDGET AND LOGISTICS

The core team is made up of missionaries who are dedicating their lives voluntarily to reach people with the Salvation message of Jesus and also provide them with the skills and physical needs to better their lives. With this in mind, we present the following budget for everyone's appreciation, in the hopes that those who will not integrate the expedition, still will be moved to sponsor in whatever way possible.

The original core team already has the equipment described under the second slot of items thus only in need of 2.470 €uros per person, if coming from Portugal. The ones who are already stationed in RSA, will only need 1.670 €uros when deducted the plane fare. The core team is composed of 3 members coming from Portugal and 7 members already stationed in RSA, which will come up to a total of 19.100 €uros. It is also part of the equipment a generator and a 4x4 jack. – Being this is a project of a considerable amount, one tends to feel overwhelmed, especially because we don't receive sponsorship from any certain source which will easily cover the amount. So we propose dividing the budgeted amount in goals to attain throughout the year. If the 19.100 €uros are divided by 12 months we then will have 12 goals of 1.592 €uros per month. We will need to find sponsorship from 12 companies and/or individuals who are interested in donating this monthly amount, which divided by 12 months comes out only 133 €uros per month each, or 4,5 €uros per day each. Are you one?! Start putting aside now!! – It is part of the project to send a container with school and medical supplies, clothes and Bibles, to be distributed among the peoples of Daque and Magoé. Doctors, nurses, engineers and other skilled persons are welcome (within the expedition requirements) to accompany and make their field of expertise available to those in need.

Porto – Johannesburg (team and accompanying staff will be received in AMA nucleus in Pretoria) – Pretoria – Witbank – Middelburg – Belfast – Nelspruit – Barberton (stop over) – Malelane – Komatipoort – Ressano Garcia (border crossing) – Moamba – Maputo (stop over) – Manhiça – Xai-Xai – Chonguene – Chidenguele – Quissico – Inharrime – Inhambane (stop over) – Morrumbene – Massinga – Rio das Pedras – Nhachengue – Mavanza – Cheline – Mapinhane – Vilanculos (stop over) – Inhassoro – Macovane – Malanguene – Mabinze – Nova Golegã – Inchope – Gôndola – Chimoio (stop over) – Nova Vandúzi – Catandica – Changara – Mandlé – Tête (stop over) – Dégué – Domingos – Cataxa – Cavalansia – Estima (starts 200km dirt road where only 4x4 vehicles can venture) – Chicoa – Janela – Massanga – Mutundumula – Nhacatunde – Pemberume – Chilema – Massapa – Gossa – Magoé
