



❶ The Tchuma Tchato Project started February 2000, when the Limpopo valley in Mozambique suffered great floods. Since then we have been busy doing our part to bring relief to the people of this country, by means of humanitarian goods and Spiritual assistance. We are a non-denominational Christian Movement worldwide, The Family International, and an NGO_D in Portugal. This will be the 10th consecutive year, project director missionary João Rodrigues, project coordinator missionary Clara Collazo and invaluable volunteers, dedicate their efforts towards this mission.

❷ Right now the two objectives are; 1) 2010 - Drill a bore hole to provide easy access to water for a clinic and 2) 2010/2011 - Offer assistance to the nearby school, both in the physical maintenance of the facilities and the teaching of the Portuguese language. These installations are located in a village called Baptine, 200km away from Maputo, in the Moamba district. These objectives are within the United Nations Millennium Development goals which are to be achieved by 2015. These goals and the time frame to their achievement are indeed ambitious and it seems an impossible mission. As far as we are concerned, it will be of the utmost necessity to endeavor efforts to each do his part. Will you help fulfill our part in this overall plan?



❸ As mentioned above, for the year 2010 we would like to drill the bore hole and supply the clinic with easy access water. The approximate cost for the bore hole is 12.000,00 dollars, which by today's rate would be 88.000,00 rand. No matter how one puts it, it will always be a big number for any day to day person, just like it is for us. But if we think chipping in, and we consider a universe of 500 people then it won't be so much for each, less than 25,00 dollars or 183,00 rand. Now the question is; is there still a free place in your heart, to consider being one of the 500? The answer is yours, and yours alone. And if you want to chip more, by all means do chip!
